

SCRIPT SAMPLE

Scene 1

(As the **intro music** plays **(track 9)** the cast enters and all sit on, around and in front of the stage. Five festively-dressed narrators stand on a small separate stage to the side of the main stage, to read their lines from scripts sitting on decorated music stands.)

The following script is written in rhyming verse. To help your cast deliver the lines so they scan properly, the underlined syllables should be stressed.

Narrator #1 A warm welcome to all of you,

How lovely that you're here!

It's Christmas, which is everybody's

Favourite time of year!

Narrator #2 And this is our Nativity,

Our <u>mu</u>sical...our <u>play</u>.

You're not surprised, you knew that, right?

It's why we're dressed this way!

Narrator #3 It's 'A <u>Happy Clappy Nativity</u>',

A <u>name</u> that fits just <u>right</u>,

'Cause happiness and clappiness

Will fill this room tonight!

Narrator #4 So, wakey-wakey everyone!

We <u>want</u> to hear no <u>snores</u>, Just <u>lots</u> of joyful <u>voi</u>ces And a <u>ton</u> of loud applause!

Narrator #5 Okay, to get things started,

Let's <u>have</u> a little <u>song</u>, And <u>you</u> are all in<u>vi</u>ted To <u>sing</u> and clap a<u>long</u>!

(As the song finishes, the main stage clears.)

Narrator #1 Our <u>story</u> starts many <u>years</u> ago,

In a distant, far-off land.

We welcome Mary to the stage -

Let's give her a big hand!

(As Mary enters, a large 'CLAP' sign is held up, encouraging everyone to give her a round of applause. Mary sits centrally on a stool.)

Narrator #2 Oh yes, and just to let you know,

This sign that we have here...(pointing to the 'CLAP' sign)

When <u>it's</u> held up, do <u>as</u> it says! Now, <u>have</u> we made that <u>clear</u>?!

Mary I <u>live</u> a very <u>sim</u>ple life,

I hope it stays that way. It's just, I've got a feeling

That's all going to change today!

Narrator #3 Well, God was watching Mary,

And her <u>feel</u>ing was spot-<u>on!</u> He <u>had</u> a job for <u>her</u> to do; That job....to have His son!

Narrator #4 So He sent her a messenger,

A <u>quite</u> important <u>chap</u>. This <u>is</u> the Angel <u>Gabriel</u> – Come <u>on</u>, give him a <u>clap</u>!

(As Gabriel enters, the 'CLAP' sign is held up and all welcome him with applause.)

Gabriel Mary, I have news for you!

It's such a joyful thing,

I'm going to tell you with a song!

(to audience) And you lot, please join in!

song Hi There, Mary

Track 2 - vocal & clap demo Track 12 - backing track with claps Track 13 - backing track without claps Lyrics p16 (As the song finishes, Gabriel exits.)

Narrator #5 Now, Mary was a little scared

Of what would come her way.

Mary And <u>Jo</u>seph, my fi<u>an</u>cé,

What on <u>earth's</u> he going to <u>say</u>?!

Narrator #1 But he promised to stand by her,

To be there through thick and thin.

Good ol' Joseph, what a guy!

Let's give it up for him!

(As Joseph enters, the 'CLAP' sign is held up. He stands by Mary's side.)

Narrator #2 Now, Joseph also had some news;

He'd <u>plan</u>ned a trip for <u>them</u>,

Back to the place where he grew up...

Joseph ...We're off to Bethlehem!

You see, the Roman emperor

Has <u>or</u>dered every<u>one</u> To register for taxes

In the town where they are from!

Narrator #3 And <u>so</u> they packed their <u>tra</u>vel bags,

Then <u>went</u> to get some <u>rest</u>. We'll <u>join</u> them in a <u>moment</u>,

And find out what happened next!

(As the intro music plays (track 14), Mary and Joseph exit.)

Scene 2

Narrator #4 And <u>so</u> the world was <u>on</u> the move,

As travellers hit the roads,

Their poor old donkeys carrying

Some pretty heavy loads!

(The stage fills with travellers and donkeys.)

Donkey #1 Come <u>rain</u> or shine, <u>hot</u> or cold,

In every kind of weather,

We all work hard, so just for us...

All Donkeys ...Please put your hands together!

(The 'CLAP' sign is held up and the donkeys accept their applause. Mary and Joseph then enter with their donkey.)

Narrator #5 Mary and Joseph joined in with

This <u>clip</u>py-cloppy <u>throng</u>, Which <u>sets</u> us up quite <u>nicely</u> For a clippy-cloppy song!

Song

Clip-Cloppin' Along The Road

Track 3 - vocal & clap demo Track 15 - backing track with claps Track 16 - backing track without claps Lyrics p17

(As the song finishes, all exit. The innkeepers then enter, each with a sign reading 'VACANCIES'. They line up along the back of the stage.)

Narrator #1 The <u>inn</u>keepers of <u>Beth</u>lehem

Were <u>all</u> very excited!

With <u>all</u> these paying <u>cus</u>tomers, In <u>fact</u>, they were delighted!

Innkeeper #1 Rooms to rent for <u>tra</u>vellers!

Come and stay the night!

Innkeeper #2 Cheap and cheerful! Nice clean sheets!

And not a rat in sight!

(The travellers enter and stand with the innkeepers. All shake hands to show deals are being made. The innkeepers then turn their signs round to now read 'NO VACANCIES'.)

Traveller #1 It seems that we arrived in town

Not one minute too soon!

Traveller #2 All the inns have filled up fast!

I'm glad we got a room!

(Mary, Joseph and the donkey then wearily enter and stand centrally.)

Narrator #2 But what about these tired two?

They <u>need</u> a place to <u>stay</u>. It's <u>kind</u> of an e<u>mergency....</u>

All THERE'S A <u>BABY</u> ON THE <u>WAY!</u>
