Sheep & Lambs	1, 2, 5	Sheep/lamb onesies, or woolly fleeces, black tights, sheep masks & horns (for older sheep)
Shepherds	1, 5	Tunics, cloaks, headdresses, beards & crooks
Bethlehem Townsfolk & Visitors	2	Tunics, cloaks & headdresses
Angels	3, 4	White gown with tinsel trim, tinsel halo & wings
Stable Animals	4	Animal onesies, or grey/brown/patterned t-shits & tights with animal masks

<sup>\*</sup> A 'line' is defined here as each time a character speaks - usually between one and five actual lines of text each time.
