<b>Stars</b>	<b>4, 5, 6</b>	Black t-shirts and leggings, star & tinsel headdress
<b>Stable Animals</b>	<b>4, 5, 6</b>	Animal onesies, or grey/brown/patterned t-shirts & tights with animal masks
<b>Shepherds</b>	<b>5, 6</b>	Tunics, cloaks, headdresses, beards & crooks
