## Reducing the cast size

Minimum Cast Number: 29
Here is our suggestion to reduce the cast size without compromising the plot.
The roles of the Activists in scenes 6,7 and 8 and the Trees in scene 2 can both be reduced to two characters and their lines redistributed.

The roles of Construction Workers in scene 8 can be reduced to one character who speaks all the lines.

Some of the speaking and non-speaking characters appear in only one scene. This allows for the 'doubling-up' of parts played by your cast, thus reducing the number you need to fulfil all the main roles, as below:

| Scabs (Sc 3) | Potato (Sc 5) |
| Checkout Girl (Sc 5) | Construction Worker (Sc 8) |
| Car Salesman (Sc 6) | Robbie Robot ( Sc 7,8) |
| Non-Speaking Parts | Also playing part/s |
| 3 x Trees (Sc 2) | $3 \times$ Food Chorus (Sc 5) |
| 3 x Rat Chorus (Sc 3) | $3 \times$ Drivers (Sc 6) |

## Increasing the cast size

To 100+
For this production, you can have unlimited numbers of non-speaking characters in the scenes where they appear. They could also feature prominently in the performance of the song associated with their particular scene:

| Non-speaking part | Appearing in scene/s |
| :--- | :---: |
| More Trees | 2 |
| The Rat Chorus | 3 |
| The Food Chorus | 5 |
| Drivers | 6 |

You could also have a dedicated choir seated to one side of the stage, to sing all songs - number unlimited.
