

Reducing the cast size

Minimum Cast Number: 30

Here is our suggestion to reduce the cast size without compromising the plot.

The roles of 'Novice Head' in Scene 3 can be reduced to three characters with their lines redistributed.

The roles of 'Narrator' in Scene 5 can be reduced to one who reads all lines.

The children in Scene 4 can be reduced to six with their lines redistributed.

Apart from the family, all the other characters only appear in one Scene. This allows for the 'doubling-up' of parts played by your cast, thus reducing the number you need to fulfil all the main roles, see suggestions below:

Increasing the cast size

To 100+

For this production, you can have **unlimited numbers of extra non-speaking characters** who They could also feature prominently in the performance of the song associated with their particular scene:

Non-speaking part	Appearing in scene/s
More Navy-Blue-Knickered Kids	1
More Photographed Kids	2
More Novice Heads	3
More Milky Children	4

You could also have a dedicated choir seated to one side of the stage, to sing all songs – number unlimited.
