Reducing the cast size

Minimum Cast Number: 33

Here is our suggestion to reduce the cast size without compromising the plot.

Mother #2, Adult #6 and #7, ARP #5 and Home Guard #5 can be removed and their lines redistributed.

Some of the speaking and non-speaking characters appear in only one scene. This allows for the 'doubling-up or 'tripling-up' of parts played by your cast, thus reducing the number you need to fulfil all the main roles, as below:

Increasing the cast size

To **100+**

For this production, you can have **unlimited numbers of non-speaking characters** in the scenes where they appear. They could also feature prominently in the performance of the song associated with their particular scene:

More ARPs	3, 10
Sheltering Families	4, 10
Working Women	5, 10
More Home Guards	6, 10
More GIs & Local Lads	7, 10

You could also have a dedicated choir seated to one side of the stage, to sing all songs – number unlimited.
