

## Reducing the cast size

## Minimum Cast Number: 27

Here is our suggestion to reduce the cast size without compromising the plot.
If you have competent performers, the roles of Narrators can be reduced to two and the lines redistributed or can be spoken together as a Greek chorus.

The roles of Women in Scene 2 can be reduced to three and their lines redistributed.
Some of the speaking and non-speaking characters appear in only one scene. This allows for the 'doubling-up' of parts played by your cast, thus reducing the number you need to fulfil all the main roles, as below:

| Speaking Part | Also playing part/s |

| Woman \#1 (Sc 2) | Harpy \#1 (Sc 3) |
| Woman \#2 (Sc 2) | Harpy \#2 (Sc 3) |
| Woman \#3 (Sc 2) | Harpy \#3 (Sc 3) |
| Phineus (Sc 3) | Aetes (Sc 5,6,7) |
| Non-Speaking Parts | Also playing part/s |
| $3 \times$ Women of Lemnos (Sc 2) | $3 \times$ Aetes Entourage (Sc 5,6,7) |
| $4 \times$ Thessalian Well-wishers (Sc 1) | $4 \times$ Aetes Ghoulish Warriors (Sc 6) |

## Increasing the cast size

## To 90+

For this production, you can have unlimited numbers of non-speaking characters in the scenes where they appear. They could also feature prominently in the performance of the song associated with their particular scene:

| Non-speaking part | Appearing in scene/s |
| :--- | :---: |
| Pelias' Entourage \& Slaves | 1,8 |
| More Argonauts | All |
| Thessalian Well-Wishers | 1 |
| More Women of Lemnos | 2 |
| Aetes' Entourage | $5,6,7$ |
| Aetes' Ghoulish Warriors | 6 |

You could also have a dedicated choir seated to one side of the stage, to sing all songs - number unlimited.
