

Reducing the cast size

Minimum Cast Number: 27

Here is our suggestion to reduce the cast size without compromising the plot.

Firstly, you can, of course, perform all scenes and songs which will give you a production lasting 90 mins +. However, we advise you choose a handful of scenes and songs to perform, to create a bespoke production of a length that suits you. As an example, we have chosen scenes 1, 2, 4, 7, and 8 and have suggested ways you can reduce the cast to the 27 minimum – details below. However, you can choose any scenes to perform and reduce the cast using our example as a guide.

Most of the speaking characters appear in only one scene. This allows for the 'doublingup' of parts played by your cast, thus reducing the number you need to fulfil all the main roles, as below:
