## Reducing the cast size

Minimum Cast Number: 16
Here is our suggestion to reduce the cast size without compromising the plot.
If you have a competent performer the roles of Narrator can be reduced to one who reads all the lines.

The roles of Cooks, Children Christmas-Present and Future Children can all be reduced to three of each and the lines redistributed. The roles of Teachers Christmas-Present can be reduced to two and the lines redistributed. The roles of Security-bot can be reduced to one who speaks all the lines.

The non-speaking characters can be removed.
Some of the speaking characters appear in only one scene. This allows for the 'doubling-up' of parts played by your cast, thus reducing the number you need to fulfil all the main roles, as below:

| Teacher 1 - past (Sc 3) | Future Child \#1 (Sc 5) |
| Young Humbug (Sc 3) | Future Child \#2 (Sc 5) |
| Cathy (Sc 3) | Future Child \#3 (Sc 5) |
| Tommy (Sc 3) | Security Bot (Sc 5) |
| Sally (Sc 3) | Spirit of Christmas Yet to Come (Sc 5,6) |

## Increasing the cast size

## To 90+

For this production, you can have unlimited numbers of non-speaking characters in the scenes where they appear. They could also feature prominently in the performance of the song associated with their particular scene:

| Non-speaking part | Appearing in scene/s |
| :--- | :---: |
| Staff and children - present day | $1,4,6$ |
| Class of School-Christmas-Past | 3 |
| Infant Nativity characters | 3 |
| Class of School-Christmas-Yet-To-Come | 5 |
| Future down-and-out teachers | 5 |

You could also have a dedicated choir seated to one side of the stage, to sing all songs - number unlimited.
