## Reducing the cast size

Minimum Cast Number: $\mathbf{2 5}$
Here is our suggestion to reduce the cast size without compromising the plot.
The roles of Children in Scene 2 can be reduced to three and their lines redistributed.
Some of the speaking and non-speaking characters appear in only one scene. This allows for the 'doubling-up' or 'tripling-up' of parts played by your cast, thus reducing the number you need to fulfil all the main roles, as below:

| Child \#1 (Sc 2) | Swim Instructor \#2 (Sc 4) |
| Child \#2 (Sc 2) | Child \#1 (Sc 4) |
| Child \#3 (Sc 2) | Child \#1 (Sc 4) |
| Child \#4 (Sc 2) | Child \#1 (Sc 4) |

## Increasing the cast size

To 90+
For this production, you can have unlimited numbers of non-speaking characters in the scenes where they appear. They could also feature prominently in the performance of the song associated with their particular scene:

| Non-speaking part | Appearing in scene/s |
| :--- | :---: |
| More PE- kitted Children | 1 |
| More Classroom Kids | 2 |
| Sports Day Parents | 3 |
| Swimmers | 4 |
| Playtime Players | 5 |

You could also have a dedicated choir seated to one side of the stage, to sing all songs - number unlimited.
