

## Reducing the cast size

Minimum Cast Number: 33

Here is our suggestion to reduce the cast size without compromising the plot.

The essential non-speaking Dancing Infant Children and Dancing Junior Children roles in Scene 7 can be performed with a minimum of 4 children each.

The non-speaking roles of More Parents and More Teachers can be removed.

Some of the speaking and non-speaking characters appear in only one scene. This allows for the 'doubling-up' of parts played by your cast, thus reducing the number you need to fulfil all the main roles, as below:

## Increasing the cast size

## To **90+**

For this production, you can have **unlimited numbers of non-speaking characters** in the scenes where they appear. They could also feature prominently in the performance of the song associated with their particular scene:

| Non-Speaking Part       | Appearing in scene/s |
|-------------------------|----------------------|
| Dancing Infant Children | 3                    |
| Dancing Junior Children | 3                    |
| More Parents            | 7                    |
| More Teachers           | 7                    |

You could also have a dedicated choir seated to one side of the stage, to sing all songs – number unlimited.
