## Reducing the cast size

Minimum Cast Number: **29**

Here is our suggestion to reduce the cast size without compromising the plot.

Because all of the cast appear in most of the scenes, and often together, there is no opportunity to double up on parts.

However, the roles of Children in Scene 3 can be reduced to three and the Tourists in Scenes 3 and 5 can be reduced to four and their lines redistributed.

## Increasing the cast size

To **80+**

For this production, you can have **unlimited numbers of non-speaking characters** in the scenes where they appear. They could also feature prominently in the performance of the song associated with their particular scene:

<b>Non-Speaking Part</b>	<b>Appearing in scene/s</b>
More Reporters	1, 5
More Children	2, 5
More Tourists	3, 5
More Scientists	3, 5
More Locals	3, 5

You could also have a dedicated choir seated to one side of the stage, to sing all songs – number unlimited.
